In many cases (/case-study-daemen-college), the primary method of emergency notification is SMS text and email alert systems. These communication methods are effective in today’s digitally connected world, but they can still miss students who might be in a building with poor cell phone reception, or their teacher or professor requires all cell phones turned off during class.

Most school officials recognize the need to address this potential gap in communications by expanding their school’s current emergency communication system. At many schools like Gordon College in Wenham, MA, (https://www.alertus.com/case-study-gordon-college) there is little or no money to dedicate towards creating a more robust mass notification system.

The tool easily integrates with existing third-party mass notification software and systems including text and email. Recently, the Alertus Desktop was updated with new features, including the capability for users to receive alerts through a locked computer screen.

We’re thrilled that more hundreds of schools have taken advantage of this philanthropic effort.
